### **Article III Members**

3.1 Classes. There shall be three (3) classes of Membership: Active, Honorary, and Associate.

C. Associate Membership: Shall be comprised of former or current employees of law enforcement related agencies or a family member of a former or current employee of law enforcement related agencies who are not eligible for membership in the Association as an Active Member. No person shall be denied membership on account of race, religion, color, creed, sex, age or national origin.

Associate Members must be nominated by an Active Member in Good Standing and voted in by the Membership in accordance with rules established by the Board of Directors.

1. Associate members, as herein defined do not have a vote in the Association.
2. Those convicted of a felony will not be eligible for membership.
