Identification Card Application Honorably Retired Peace Officers

This is an application for an identification card to identify a person as an honorably retired peace officer, as authorized by Texas Government Code, Section 614.124, Honorably Retired Peace Officer. For purposes of this application Honorably Retired means a former peace officer who:

- Previously served but is not currently serving as an elected, appointed, or employed peace officer under Art. 2.12., code of Criminal Procedure, or other law;
- Did not retire in lieu of any disciplinary action;
- Was eligible to retire from a law enforcement agency in this state or was ineligible to retire only as a result of an injury received in the course of the officer's employment with the agency; and
- Is eligible to receive a pension or annuity for service as a law enforcement officer in this state or is ineligible to receive a pension or annuity only because the law enforcement agency that employed the officer does not offer a pension or annuity to its employees.

ACTION NEEDED BY YOU:

- Sign the application as a verification of the accuracy of the information submitted.
- Email the signed application to APD Internal Affairs @ internal.affairs@austintexas.gov. APD's Internal Affairs Commander/Designee will verify your retirement status and sign below.
- The Internal Affairs designee will email your application to the Chief's Office for approval. You will be copied when your application is emailed to the Chief's Office.
- When your application has been signed by the Chief/Designee, it will be emailed to the APD Main, Control Booth; you will be copied on this email also. When you receive this email you should call the Control Booth, 512-974-5061, and make an appointment to have your ID card made.
- Report lost or stolen ID cards immediately to APD Watch Commander at 512-974-7822.
- While carrying a weapon on your person it must be concealed at all times; unless otherwise authorized by the Chief of Police or designee. Violation of this rule shall be cause to revoke your identification card.
